



Building a Life Nurturing Ministry

PREPARES, short for Pregnancy and Parenting Support, launched in October of 2014 at the Cornerstone Conference sponsored by the Washington State Catholic Conference. The four Bishops of the State announced that their new Initiative would support parishes to outreach and accompany pregnant women and families with children under the age of five. When we created PREPARES five years ago, our hope was that by building a collective network of parishes led by local parishioners working in conjunction with Catholic Charities we could reach more families who have been left on the margins. After five years, PREPARES has realized our goal to provide meaningful, local and sustainable support to vulnerable Washington mothers, fathers, and families as they nurture their children through pregnancy and early childhood.

- To date, PREPARES has a team of equivalent 8 full time staff who have engaged and support over 150 parishes. These parishes span 3 dioceses and 3 Catholic Charity regions. They consist of rural, suburban, and urban areas and are serving pregnant women and families in 34 of 39 counties.
- ♥ With funding through the Catholic Campaign for Human Development we developed a network of parish communities resulting in the ability to serve over 16,000 families. We projected serving up to 4,000 annually but exceeded our goal by serving more than 6,000 families in 2018.
- ▼ We have created sustainable relationships with over 150 parishes, pastors and Catholic organizations such as Knights of Columbus, St. Vincent de Paul, Catholic Daughters, and more. PREPARES has become a valued resource in our community across the state of Washington and an interwoven part of the life and Catholic Charities community.
